On April 25, 7 pm, in the Martin Polin Community Room of the Atascadero Public Library, Gordon Fuglie will lecture on the rise of Christian nationalism and its prominence in the Republican presidential campaign and conservative politics. The event is hosted by the Atascadero Democratic Club.

Upon announcing his presidential bid in 2015, Donald Trump courted conservative white evangelical Christians by promising to redress their social fears, cultural grievances, and use federal power to give them dominion over American life. In the 2016 election, more than 80% of white evangelical voters supported Trump.

Others advocate for immigration restrictions specifically to prevent a change to American religious and ethnic demographics or a change to American culture. Some want to empower the government to take stronger action to circumscribe immoral behavior."

President Joe Biden has been dogged for months by pro-Palestinian protesters calling him "Genocide Joe" — but some of the groups behind the demonstrations receive financial backing from philanthropists pushing hard for his reelection.

The donors include some of the biggest names in Democratic circles: Soros, Rockefeller and Pritzker, according to a POLITICO analysis.

Two of the organizers supporting the protests at Columbia University and on other campuses are Jewish Voice for Peace and IfNotNow. Both are supported by the Tides Foundation, which is seeded by Democratic megadonor George Soros and was previously supported by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. It in turn supports numerous small nonprofits that work for social change.

Soros declined to comment. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, which has previously funded the Tides Foundation and other groups, said it no longer has active grants to Tides. It also does not support Jewish Voice for Peace or IfNotNow.

Another notable Democratic donor whose philanthropy has helped fund the protest movement is David Rockefeller Jr., who sits on the board of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund. In 2022, the fund gave \$300,000 to the Tides Foundation; according to nonprofit tax forms, Tides has given nearly \$500,000 over the past five years to Jewish Voice for Peace, which explicitly describes itself as anti-Zionist.

Several other groups involved in pro-Palestinian protests are backed by a foundation funded by Susan and Nick Pritzker, heir to the Hyatt Hotel empire — and supporters of Biden and numerous Democratic campaigns, including






Manufacturing Jobs

Fuglie sounds a lot like Jim Wallis




The conservative Christian advocacy organization released its latest "Hostility Against Churches" report this month, which FRC updated to include hostility incidents from the calendar year 2023.

"It's not an idol," said artist and former youth pastor Tommy Zegan, reported MediaITE. "I know the biblical definition of an idol. This is not an idol. This is a sculpture."

The 200-pound fiberglass statue of the former president, titled Trump and his Magic Wand, was made in Rosarito, Mexico, and later painted in Tampa, Florida, Politico reported. The artist said the statue was then U-Hauled to Orlando, where it was on display for CPAC 2021. Zegan said that he'd sell it for \$100,000.

The gilded Trump is dressed in red flip-flops, American flag shorts and a black suit coat over a white dress shirt and red tie. Trump, whose head, hands and legs are painted gold, holds the U.S. Constitution in his right hand and a star-capped wand in his left. The "magic wand" refers a comment made by former President Barack Obama in 2016, when he <u>figuratively asked "what magic wand do you have"</u> of Trump's plan to bring lost manufacturing jobs back to America.

"The coat and tie is the fact that he's a professional, he's a businessman," Zegan told CNN. "The red tie symbolizes <u>he's a Republican</u>. The red white and blue is that he's a patriot. The fact that he's wearing thongs and shorts is that he's at the age where he should be retired. He should be at the beach right now."

Some important philosophical influences on the Constitution include the colonial and state constitutions, the Great Awakening, modern Enlightenment thinkers, and the Declaration of Independence. Notably, all of these particular influences were shaped by a **God-oriented worldview based on and/or consistent with the Bible**. This worldview was held by colonial and founding-era Americans as well as by the political philosophers they read. In fact, the Bible itself was also a very strong, direct influence on founding-era Americans who drafted and ratified the Constitution.
